## I. Principal's Report

### 1. Capital Projects Request – *due Friday*

#### a. Requests through the CEC

- i. If we want to upgrade or improve (auditorium, cafeteria, PA system, playground, etc.) – **most of the things that we could ask for funding for we already have in the works or have done (auditorium project was approved, but delayed from past summer to this summer, PA system was already updated with auditorium sound system, playground is on Shekar's budget line)***
- ii. **Ms. Jurofsky requested window improvements (atrium specifically), there are several that cannot be opened***
- iii. **Ms. Syed requested a cafeteria upgrade***
- iv. **Ms. Bauder asked about water fountains - Reso A requests will come January/February, which - ask from councilmember***

## II. Class Size Law

### ● Plan

- **Ms. Ciorciari clarified there is a difference between schoolwide compliance and statewide compliance***
- **On 10/31, an email went out to all principals about the class size plan and with information about the plan template that would be sent separately. Plan template***

- never sent to Ms. Ciorciari; she had to ask another principal for it - we suspect because PS 69 is already 40% in compliance, the template was not sent to us.*
- *Superintendent Hildago was here on Monday and spoke about smaller class size - she advised, if we have the space to do it and rooms are available, you should apply for funding for lowering class sizes.*
  - *The state can show up any time without invitation or warning, and if they see empty classrooms, they can sneak in charter classes. If they see you're not utilizing the classrooms or using them in the right way, they can put in D75 on the floor.*
  - Continue to review drafted plan
  - Review second email sent by Chairperson Ms. Cregan indicating her reasoning for no need for 100% smaller class size nor the need for an additional Assistant Principal
    - Based on Ms. Cregan's account the school should only expand to grades K and 2, 3
      - Review email
      - Review Updated 12/9/24 Small Class Size FAQ
      - **FAQ Now includes Rubric for Expectations** – *Rubric just updated on Monday - we have the space, we were able to hire 3 ENL teacher this year, we are probably between a 2 and a 3*
  - Can reach 100% this year if school because we have the room
    - Rooms available: 100 (Move to the Music House/Art House), 101, 138, 149, 220, 306, 402, 407, 408, 502, 506, PO1/PO2, or PO3/PO4
    - It's about making an impact on day-to-day classroom learning
    - K-3 = 20 students
    - Gr. 4-5 = 23 students
  - CSA, UFT, & NYCPS will review plans
  - Plan is a lot of work - Thank you Mr. Harden for your feedback in the plan template!
  - *Majority of SLT still in favor of aiming for 100% compliance, which means we'll need to work on grade K, 2, 3, 4, 5*
  - **Due 12/20/24**
